For EXPO CHICAGO 2022, Rebecca Camacho Presents is pleased to highlight a solo exhibition of new paintings and works on paper by Austin TX based artist Claire Oswalt. Known for subconscious-driven explorations on paper that are then meticulously recalibrated to sewn canvas duplicates, Oswalt's latest series is a concentration of dense and vibrant color on a grand scale.

Lush and luminous, Oswalt's abstract figurations blur perspective and proportion. Legible as either immersive environments or finely tuned details, the works retain a spirit of wildness at their core, and a suggestion of what hangs just outside of the painting's frame. The technical precision of Oswalt's practice expertly balances the loose fluidity of her visual surfaces.

A seventh-generation Texan, Claire Oswalt received her BFA from the University of Southern California in 2001. She has been included in exhibitions nationally and internationally including recent solo presentations at Broadway, New York NY, and Lora Reynolds Gallery, Austin TX. She is currently featured in *Thaw: Winter Group Show*, at the Landing, Los Angeles CA. Her solo exhibitions *Holy Smokes* is on view at Rebecca Camacho Presents, San Francisco CA through 23 April.
